The Adams-Meeks Fund benefits students affiliated with Northwest Baptist Convention churches working toward a Doctor of Ministry degree. Please note that we do not offer a scholarship for Ph.D. studies.

It is your responsibility to fully complete your application before being considered for an award. Applications are accepted at any time of year, and you may reapply for a second or subsequent year of your program.

- 1. Typed, completed, and signed Application Form;
- 2. Spiritual Journey essay (detailed instructions provided on Application Form);
- 3. A copy of your degree plan with indication of where you are in the process and/or a current grade report or transcript (may be unofficial).

Optional: Submit a digital photo of you doing something that shows us a little about you. We would like to use your photo for promotional pieces to encourage donors and future applicants. If you do not want your photo used, please do not submit one.
